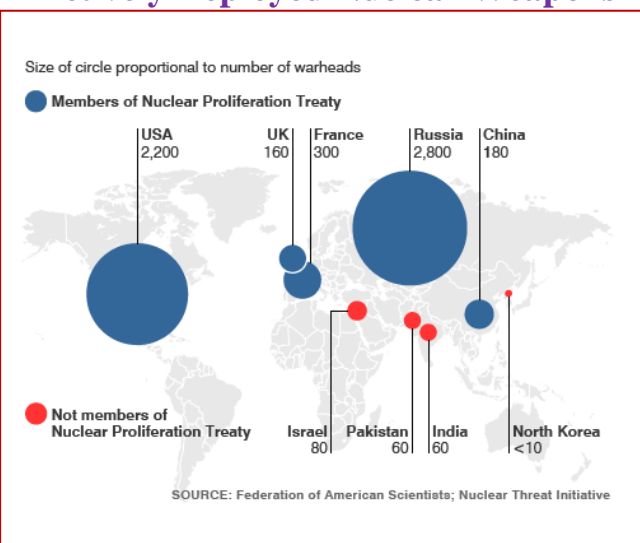


**A path towards Zero:** In December 2008 in Paris—in response to the growing threats of proliferation and nuclear terrorism—100 leaders from around the world launched *Global Zero*. They announced a plan for the phased, verified elimination of nuclear weapons, starting with deep reductions in the U.S. and Russian arsenals, to be followed by multilateral negotiations among all nuclear powers for an agreement to eliminate all nuclear weapons—global zero. The growing group includes former heads of state, former foreign ministers, former defense ministers, former national security advisors, and more than 20 former top military commanders

**Threat to human existence:** Recent scientific studies predict the detonation of 1% of the explosive power contained in the operational US and Russian nuclear arsenals would cause catastrophic destruction of the global environment and ecosystems. Thus a nuclear war fought with these weapons would leave the Earth uninhabitable. Because the US and Russia still keep 30% of their nuclear weapons on high-alert, quick-launch status, these weapons can literally end human existence in a matter of minutes.

### THE COST OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS!!!

Total US nuclear weapon costs for 1946-1996.



- Building the Bomb -- 7%
- Deploying the Bomb -- 57%
- Targeting and Controlling the Bomb -- 14.3%
- Defending Against the Bomb -- 16.1%
- Dismantling the Bomb -- 0.5%
- Nuclear Waste Management and Environmental Remediation -- 6.3%
- Victims of the Bomb -- 0.04% (\$2.1 billion, not shown)
- Nuclear Secrecy -- 0.05% (\$3.1 billion, not shown)
- Congressional Oversight of the Bomb -- 0.02% (\$9 billion, not shown)

**President Obama** has called for a world without nuclear weapons.

**Steps toward abolition:** In 2007, 46 organizations joined to create the *Campaign for a Nuclear Weapons Free World* to promote practical steps today to free the world from nuclear weapons tomorrow. There are now **more than 100 organizations** that have joined this coalition. We call on Congress and President Obama to make a world free of nuclear weapons an urgent priority, and to demonstrate U.S. leadership by taking steps to realize this goal. Forty years ago, the fear of nuclear weapons falling into the hands of more countries led to the creation of international agreements to limit their spread. The foundation of these efforts, the Nuclear Nonproliferation Treaty (NPT), commits non-nuclear weapon states to permanently forswear nuclear weapons and requires the original nuclear weapon states -- England, China, France, Russia and the US -- to pursue and reach nuclear disarmament. 189 nations have signed the NPT.

**Global Zero's** 20-year plan includes four phases:

**Phase 1** (2010 to 2013): negotiating a bilateral accord between the U.S. and Russia to reduce total warheads to 1,000 each.

**Phase 2** (2014 to 2018): Agreement to reduce warheads to 500 each (implemented by 2021) as long as other countries agree to freeze their stockpiles by 2018. Countries would establish a verification and enforcement system and strengthen safeguards on civilian nuclear fuels to prevent diversion of materials to build weapons.

**Phase 3** (2019 to 2023): Negotiate phased, verified, proportional reductions of nuclear arsenals to zero by 2030.

**Phase 4** (2024 to 2030): Complete reduction and continue verification and enforcement.

But the United States and eight other key nations must still ratify before the START or CTBT can become law.

*In the US we ratify in the SENATE!*
